Leading the chorus is Artistic Director Barbara Acosta accompanied by the gifted pianist, Merrill Collins, composer, producer, and CEO of her Indie label, Spiraling Music. Composed of talented community singers, the chorus will take you through various winter stories and poems put to song followed by a carol sing-along at the end!

For the first time the Tap Dancing Christmas will join the Alameda Sings! Chorus as guest performers. They are a Bay Area holiday staple and Alameda Sings! is honored to have them. Returning to the Alameda Sings! chorus as guest performers are The Bay Area Music Project Children's Chorus, as well as Michael Moore on drums. The BAMP Children's Chorus is always a delightful addition to Alameda Sings! concerts and have performed with the chorus several times in the past. A local musician who you may remember from our Spring 2025 concert, Michael teaches drumming to children and adults at the Drum Lab. All our guest performers will greatly highlight the singers, the songs, and the "Stories of Winter"!
